Duke University is a private research university in Durham, North Carolina. As of 2018, 13 Nobel laureates and 3 Turing Award winners have been affiliated with the university. Further, Duke alumni include 40 Rhodes Scholars and 25 Churchill Scholars. As of 2018, Duke also holds a top-ten position in several national rankings, ranked 7th and 8th in The Times Higher Education and U.S. News & World Report, respectively.

From its early days as Brown's Schoolhouse, Duke has evolved into a global academic and research powerhouse. Its Levine Science Research Center is the largest single-site interdisciplinary research facility of any American university.

A total of around 15,000 students attend Duke, with the majority of them being postgraduates. There is an 8:1 student-to-faculty ratio, which personalizes the learning experience.
