Established in 1971, **Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST)** is a national research university located in Daejeon, South Korea, and is well-known as the nation's first research-oriented science and engineering institution. In 2016/17, the QS World University Rankings ranked KAIST 46th overall in the world and 6th within Asia, coming 13th in Material Sciences and 14th in Engineering and Technology. According to QS subject rankings 2019, KAIST is ranked at 17th, 20th, and 23rd in Material Sciences, Electrical & Electronic Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering, respectively.

KAIST has approximately 10,000 students, of which 61.7% enrolled in graduate programs.
