



## About

Moscow State University (MSU) often abbreviated is a public research university located in Moscow, Russia. It houses the tallest educational building in the world and hosts more than 47,000 students, welcoming 4,000 international students every year. According to the 2018 QS World University Rankings, it is the highest-ranking Russian educational institution and is widely considered the most prestigious university in the former Soviet Union.

MSU students benefit from the university's impressive library, the oldest and one of the largest university library systems in the country, holding around 10 million books, 2.5 million of which are in foreign languages.

There are also multiple research institutes, research centers and museums connected to the university, including the Research Computing Center and International Laser Center.

Lomonosov Moscow State University was ranked 101-110 in the most recent QS Graduate Employability Rankings, making it the highest-ranked Russian university for graduate employability.
