The Technion – Israel Institute of Technology is a public research university in Haifa, Israel. Established in 1912, the Technion is the oldest university in the country and is ranked the best university in Israel and in the whole of the Middle East in the Shanghai Ranking 2018. Technion's faculty members currently include three Nobel Laureates in chemistry. In addition, four Nobel Laureates have been associated with the university.

The Technion has played a major role in the history of modern Israel. It is also a major factor behind the growth of Israel's high-tech industry and innovation, including the country's technical cluster in Silicon Wadi.

The university has more than 13,000 students with 28% currently enrolled in postgraduate programs.
