Texas A&M University is a public research university in College Station, Texas, United States. As of 2017, Texas A&M's student body is the largest in Texas and the second largest in the United States and the main campus is one of the largest in the United States, spanning 21 km². Domestically, Texas A&M is ranked 66th by US News. Globally, the university is among the top 200 universities in the world in the QS World University Rankings 2019.

As a leading graduate research university and the state's first public institution, Texas A&M offers 94 doctoral programs and 151 master-level programs. Many of these programs have attained national recognition for quality by the National Research Council (NRC). Texas A&M enrolls approximately 45,000 students, of which nearly 8,000 are graduate students.

The graduate faculty is comprised of over 2,500 faculty members, of which many are also members of the National Academy of Sciences and the National Academy of Engineering.
