The University of Texas at Austin is a public research university in Austin, Texas. It was founded in 1883 and is the flagship institution of the University of Texas System. Among university faculty are recipients of the Nobel Prize, Pulitzer Prize, the Wolf Prize, the Primetime Emmy Award, the Turing Award, and the National Medal of Science, as well as many other awards. As of October 2018, 11 Nobel Prize winners, 2 Turing Award winners and 1 Fields medalist have been affiliated with the school as alumni, faculty members or researchers. The University of Texas at Austin is consistently ranked among the country's top universities. Nationally, it was ranked tied for 49th among all universities, and tied for 15th place among public universities, according to U.S. News & World Report's 2019 rankings. Internationally, UT Austin was ranked at #63 globally by QS World University Rankings 2019.
