Tokyo Institute of Technology is a national research university located in Greater Tokyo area, Japan. Tokyo Tech is the largest institution for higher education in Japan focusing on science and technology, and is generally considered to be one of the most prestigious universities in Japan. It is ranked 58th worldwide in the 2019 QS World University Rankings.

Tokyo Tech is one of the top research institutions in natural sciences and technology in Japan. According to Thomson Reuters, its research excellence is especially distinctive in Materials Science (5th in Japan, 24th in the world), Physics (5th in Japan, 31st in the world), and Chemistry (5th in Japan, 22nd in the world). In addition, according to the QS World University Rankings on 2012/19 surveyed about the general standards in Engineering & Technology field, Tokyo Tech was placed 19th (world), 2nd(national).
