The **University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB)** is a public research university in Santa Barbara, California. It joined the University of California system in 1944 and is the third-oldest general-education campus in the system. UCSB is one of America's Public Ivy universities and is a comprehensive doctoral university. UCSB was ranked fifth among U.S. public universities and 37th among Best Global Universities by U.S. News & World Report's 2019 rankings. QS Rankings placed UCSB at 132nd position in its edition in 2019. Current UCSB faculty includes six Nobel Prize laureates and one Fields Medalist.

UCSB's 1,000-member faculty includes five Nobel Prize winners and scores of elected members or fellows of the National Academy of Sciences, the National Academy of Engineering, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.
