Yale University is a private Ivy League research university in New Haven, Connecticut. Founded in 1701, it is the third-oldest institution of higher education in the United States. As of October 2018, 61 Nobel laureates, 5 Fields Medalists and 3 Turing award winners have been affiliated with Yale University. In addition, Yale has graduated many notable alumni, including five U.S. Presidents and 19 U.S. Supreme Court Justices. The U.S. News & World Report has consistently ranked Yale 3rd among U.S. national universities, trailing only Princeton and Harvard. Internationally, it was ranked 12th in the 2018 Academic Ranking of World Universities, 8th in the 2018 Times Higher Education Rankings and 15th in the QS World University Rankings 2019.
