VinUni's commitment to global education excellence was underscored

by becoming a partner with 41 top universities worldwide. Many third-year undergraduate students were accepted to pursue their Master's degrees at prestigious institutions such as the University of Pennsylvania, Cornell University, UIUC, University of Technology Sydney, and the University of Queensland.

Our esteemed team of professors and lecturers made remarkable contributions, publishing over 200 scientific papers, with more than 40% of them in Q1-ranked journals. Our research centers have achieved success, placing a strong emphasis on the realms of Artificial Intelligence, environmental studies, and sustainability sciences.

As we reflect on these accomplishments, we eagerly anticipate continued growth and innovation in the years ahead. VinUni remains committed to shaping the future of education, research, and sustainable development."

# About Us

VinUniversity (VinUni) is an excellent, private, not-for-profit university established by Vingroup. VinUni aspires to develop talents for the future, to make a breakthrough in Vietnam higher education and to become a world-class university.

With the goal of becoming the youngest university in the top 500 of the world's universities by 2030, VinUni has built strategic partnership with two of the world's top 20 Universities, namely Cornell University and the University of Pennsylvania.

Established on the highest standards of research, teaching, career development and international outlook, within the first year, VinUniversity was awarded Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) 5 stars rating for three aspects: Facilities, Academic Development and Inclusiveness. The institution also signs collaboration agreements to offer integrated dual-degree with universities leading in computer science, technology, business management and health sciences.

VinUniversity's inauguration ceremony was held on its campus located at Vinhomes Ocean Park, Gia Lam, Hanoi, with a total investment of VND 6,500 billion (approximately USD 285 million) from Vingroup.

The institution comprises of College of Arts and Sciences; College of Business and Management; College of Engineering and Computer Science; and College of Health Sciences. It currently offers 16 degree programs, offered from bachelor, master, PhD level namely:

- ▶ Bachelor of Business Administration
- ▶ Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering; Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering; Bachelor of Science in Computer Science; Bachelor of Science in Data Science; Master of Innovation in Artificial Intelligence; Doctor of Philosophy in Computer Science
- ▶ Bachelor of Nursing; Medical Doctor Program; Internal Medicine Residency Program; General Surgery Residency Program; Pediatrics Residency Program; Orthopedic Residency Program





# Founding Group

VinUniversity was founded by Vingroup Joint Stock Company (Vingroup JSC) as a private, not-for-profit university for the purpose of fostering and developing talents for the future.

Vingroup, formerly known as Technocom Corporation, was founded in 1993 in Ukraine. In the early 2000s, Vingroup started in Vietnam with two key brands: Vincom and Vinpearl. In January 2012, Vinpearl JSC merged with Vincom JSC to form Vingroup Joint Stock Company.

Vingroup is one of the biggest private conglomerates in Asia. As a multisector corporation, Vingroup focuses on three main areas:

- ▶ Commercials & Services;
- ▶ and Social Enterprises.

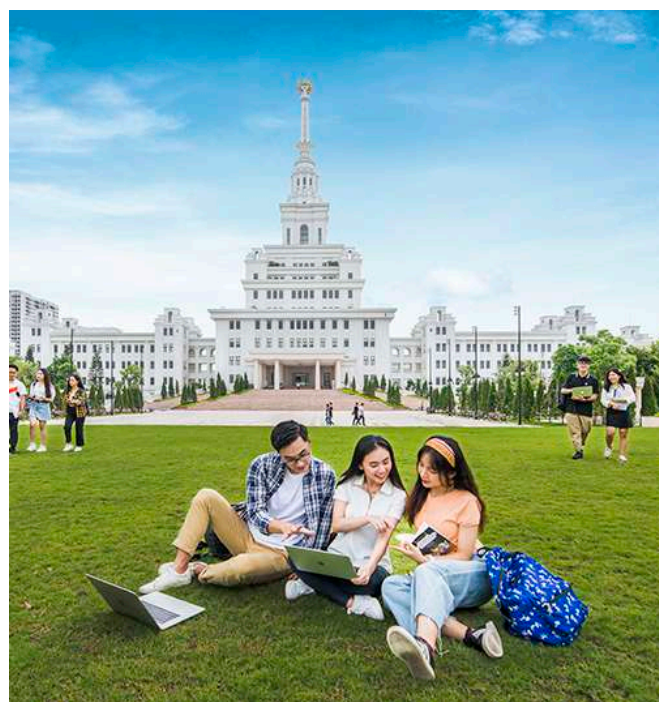


## Impressive First-Year Experience

- ▶ University of Technology Sydney (Australia), ranked #11 among young universities worldwide - QS ranking 2022 (2 agreements).
- ▶ University of Queensland (Australia), ranked #47 globally by QS World University Ranking 2022, and #3 in Australia according to USNews 2022.
- ▶ Cornell University (USA), ranked #20 globally by QS 2023 (3 agreements).
- ▶ University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (USA), ranked #4 in postgraduate engineering and #3 in Environmental Engineering by US News 2022 (2 agreements).
- ▶ Nanyang Technological University (NTU), ranked #26 globally by QS - agreement signed in December 2023.



### Bridging the Gaps between Academic and Industry

Besides equipping students with academic knowledge, VinUniversity has developed special learning and practical programs to prepare graduates for real-life challenges, with hands-on learning and real-world experience:

- ▶ The Entrepreneurship Lab helps develop students' start-up ideas, and provides them the opportunities to interact with and learn from renowned experts and entrepreneurs.
- ▶ Industry Mentorship Program where students are paired with an advisor to learn from their experience and get to know the particular industry sector.
- ▶ Summer Internship enables students to challenge themselves at more than 10 companies in the fields of finance, hospitality, technology, industry, start-ups, and so on.



### Research for Humanity

In this academic year, VinUni has total of 203 Scopus-indexed publications, 40% of these publications belong to Q1 journals. VinUni has become a destination for business leaders and reputable scholars to share research findings in various fields: Industry Innovation, Excellence in Service Management, Smart Environment and Health, Talent Education, Energy and Sustainable Development... Research centers have successfully registered exclusive patents, aiming towards commercialization, especially in the fields of smart healthcare and 3D technology in medicine.

# Strategic Collaborations

## VinGroup-Penn Collaboration

University of Pennsylvania (Penn) has entered a formal agreement with VinGroup, the Founding Benefactor of VinUniversity, to commit to excellence in clinical care and education, improve health care, and create new undergraduate and graduate medical training programs in Vietnam. Penn has provided tremendous support in establishing the College of Health Sciences at VinUniversity. Together, Penn Medicine and Penn Nursing are developing the undergraduate curriculum and aligning faculty and institutional support structures to establish high caliber educational and training programs.

## Cornell-VinUniversity Collaboration

Cornell University's primary role is to build VinUni's faculty and academic leadership teams; to validate and assure the quality of the curricula developed by VinUniversity faculty; and to guide VinUniversity on a path towards international accreditations. Cornell faculty members provide advice to lay the foundation to position VinUniversity as a world-class teaching and research university in accordance with QS 5-star rating standards.

Since the beginning, Cornell University has been involved in every aspect of VinUniversity's development including infrastructure, governance, faculty, admissions, and curriculum development. The Cornell-VinUniversity Project Team has provided support in founding VinUniversity with the participation of 200 faculty and staff, who have flown 687,000 miles on 40 trips to reach Vietnam. To strengthen their commitment, Cornell approved a multi-year leave for Professor Rohit Verma (Dean of External Relations, Cornell SC Johnson College of Business and Singapore Tourism Board Distinguished Professor), to assume the responsibility of Founding Provost of VinUniversity.



Following the strategic cooperation between the two universities, in August 2020, Cornell University and VinUniversity signed an agreement on the student exchange program. This program allows Cornell students to spend their time at VinUniversity as exchange students starting from the 2021 spring semester. An equal number of VinUniversity students have the opportunity to study at Cornell University for the same duration. Students participating in the program will have their academic qualifications and study periods abroad recognized by both universities. This will also set the path for VinUniversity to discuss new projects, including dual degrees in both universities, with Cornell as well as other prestigious international universities.

# Academic Highlights

## Education Excellence

*This past year has been a testament to the dedication and creativity of our academic community. Through collaborative efforts, we have embraced unique approaches to education that resonate with both students and educators. In this section, we celebrate the milestones, initiatives, and successes that exemplify our commitment to fostering a culture of excellence in education.*

### Quality of Educational Programs

- ▶ All academic programs undergo thorough revalidation through partnerships with Cornell University and the University of Pennsylvania, ensuring the recognition of curriculum design adhering to the highest standards of quality. This process underscores our commitment to maintaining excellence in education. Additionally, students were provided with unique opportunities to participate in classes taught by professors from Cornell and UPenn as part of their academic experience.



- ▶ In 2022, VinUni partnered with MIT-JWEL, a collaborative initiative driving innovative education solutions. This project aims to elevate the first-year student experience through advanced teaching methods, technological integration, and global educational collaboration. During the May 2023

visit, the MIT-JWEL delegation, including Dr. Anjali Sastry and Dr. Glenda Stump, provided valuable insights, analyzed focus areas, and offered consultations for enhancing the quality of education. This collaboration also facilitated connections with MIT experts, enriching VinUni's resources.



- ▶ This year marked the introduction of several new academic programs, expanding our offerings to include a PhD in Computer Science, Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, Bachelor of Arts in Media Communication, Bachelor of Arts in Economics, and a Graduate Medical Education Residency in Orthopedic Surgery. This initiative aims to diversify our academic portfolio, providing students with a broader array of study options and facilitating pathways for further academic advancement.
- ▶ The Bachelor of Nursing achieved a significant milestone by submitting the Candidacy report in

October, leading to a subsequent site visit from ACEN experts in November. The collaborative efforts of the entire university and support service units facilitated a successful visit, earning positive feedback from ACEN. The official letter, granting Candidacy for the baccalaureate nursing program as the very first University in Vietnam to attain this status, was released after the visit.



- ▶ The three GME programs successfully completed the remote site visit with Dr. Margaret Mulligan, ACGME-I Field Representative for Program Accreditation. Review results from the Review Committee will be available in January 2024. If succeed, VinUni Internal Medicine Residency Program, General Surgery Residency Program, and Pediatrics Residency will be the first ever GME programs in Vietnam to achieve ACGME International Accreditation.



### Teaching and Learning Excellence

Since the inception of VinUniversity, we have placed a tremendous emphasis on active learning and helping students learn more effectively through student-centered approaches, rather than traditional lectures. From innovative pedagogies like Team-Based Learning (TBL), Case-Based Teaching (CBT), to experiential learning through industry visits and field trips, to collaborative projects and assisting faculty with research projects, VinUniversity is strongly committed to student-centered learning.

- ▶ Promoting Experiential Learning: The "[Vinheritage Metaverse Museum of Environmental Intelligence](#)" project won the Bronze medal at the QS Reimagine Education awards in the category "Experiential Learning". It was chosen out of 1,200 entries spanning 17 distinct award categories. Two other VinUniversity projects related to the student experience and community engagement were also shortlisted and received acclaim from the judging committees. The metaverse project also won

“Outstanding Digital Content Product in the Education Sector” in the Digital Content Creation Alliance prize organized by the Vietnam Digital Media Association.



- ▶ **Teaching Innovation Grants:** The VinUniversity Teaching Innovation Grant aims to recognize and support faculty members who go above and beyond to bring fresh approaches and creative solutions to the classroom. After a rigorous screening process by the Learning Excellence Committee, five outstanding projects were selected to receive a grant of up to US\$1,000. Projects range from outcome mapping in our Learning Management System,

mobile information literacy, professionalism in medical doctor students, using big data and AI to analyze learner behavior, and competency-based medical education in Vietnam. The innovative ideas and commitment to enhancing the learning experience significantly impacts our teaching methods and the overall quality of education at VinUniversity and beyond.

- ▶ **Ignite: A Celebration of Active Learning:** The “Ignite: Celebration of Learning Week” was held in June 2023 to bring together the vibrant community of educators and learners at VinUniversity to celebrate our successes, promote conversations about teaching and learning, and pause to reflect on how innovative learning looks like at VinUniversity. This annual week-long event is a platform for educators to collaboratively explore, share, and demonstrate effective approaches to teaching and learning by sharing best practices and having novel conversations about teaching and learning. Faculty opened up their classrooms for observers to watch their teaching, and students got

involved in presentations about how they learn most effectively. The event is a unique opportunity to devote attention to active learning strategies, innovative teaching approaches, and the latest research on active learning. Through this event, faculty, teaching assistants, and students inspired new ideas and initiatives that will shape the future of education at VinUniversity and beyond.

- ▶ **Teaching Excellence Awards:** The 3rd Annual Teaching Excellence Awards were organized to recognize excellence in teaching and in teaching-related activities that inspire and stimulate student learning and foster student success. In total, 145 nominations were submitted by students, peers, and staff to nominate instructors and teaching assistants who have exemplified a strong commitment to active learning and adopted innovative approaches to engage students and support student learning. After a rigorous and transparent selection process, the prestigious awards were granted to six faculty and two teaching assistants.

## Culture of Quality Enhancement

- ▶ The year 2023 marked a significant year for quality initiatives at VinUniversity. We officially introduced the Higher Education Quality Assurance Regulations, establishing a structured quality assurance framework between the university and its colleges.
- ▶ A team of 17 quality assurance staff, selected by their leaders, underwent specialized training known as VinUni-IQA. This training, covering both local and international quality assurance contexts, equipped participants with essential knowledge for higher education and accreditation exercises. Throughout the year, more than 200 individuals took part in six workshops, facilitated by seven local and international experts. These trained staff members are set to play a nuclear role in promoting a culture of quality across the University.
- ▶ Simultaneously, accreditation processes for both the institution



and programs, aligning with the highest international standards, provided valuable experiences for involved staff and speak out the importance of quality assurance toward international recognition. Faculty and staff gained familiarity with quality instruments such as benchmarking, evaluations, and internal assessments. This would facilitate a comprehensive review of our education quality following the inaugural graduation cohort in June 2024, allowing us to strategically address crucial improvement areas.

- ▶ Recognizing our pivotal role in bridging local and international values in quality assurance

practices, VinUniversity extended its visibility at regional agenda. In 2023, we successfully hosted the final ASEAN-QA conference with the theme “Developing HEIs and Addressing External Challenges: Higher Education Management and the Role of QA”. Within this framework, VinUniversity successfully concluded the ASEAN-QA project, titled “Developing the Internal Quality Assurance System at VinUniversity”, with the mentorship of European and ASEAN experts, showcased our commitment to global quality standards.



## Research Highlights

In the realm of publications and citations, this year witnessed a notable surge in research output, boasting a total of 203 Scopus-indexed publications, 40% of these publications belong to Q1 journals, reflecting a high impact and quality within the academic community. Additionally, there was a commendable increase in Scopus citations compared to the previous year. Notably, the year marked the initiation of external funding from a funding body, laying the gradual foundation for research excellence.

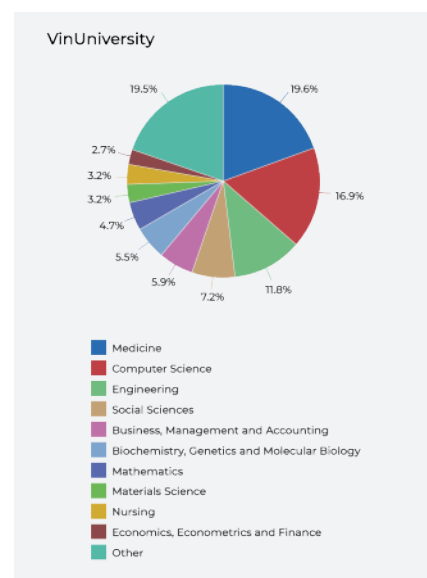


Figure 2. VinUni publications documented by subject area. Source: SCOPUS

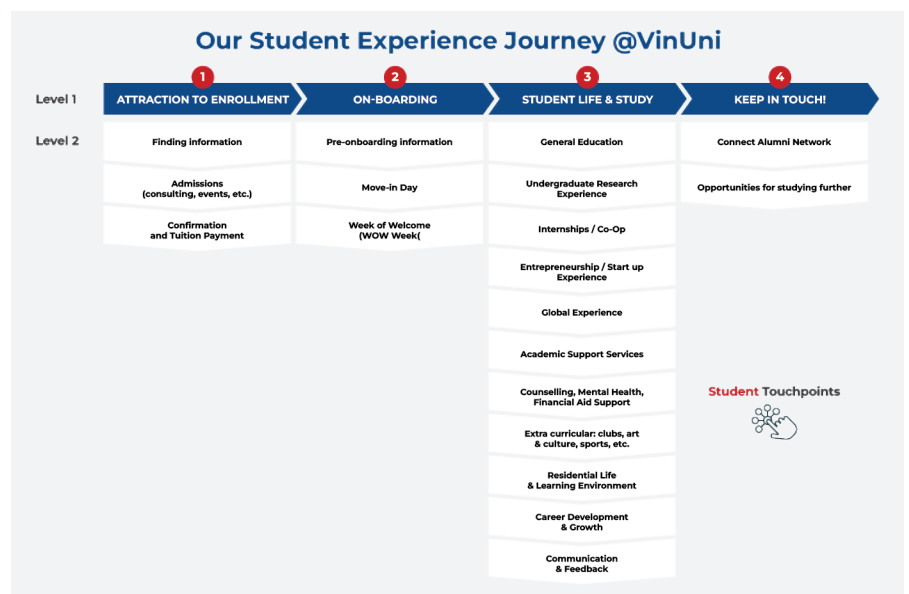

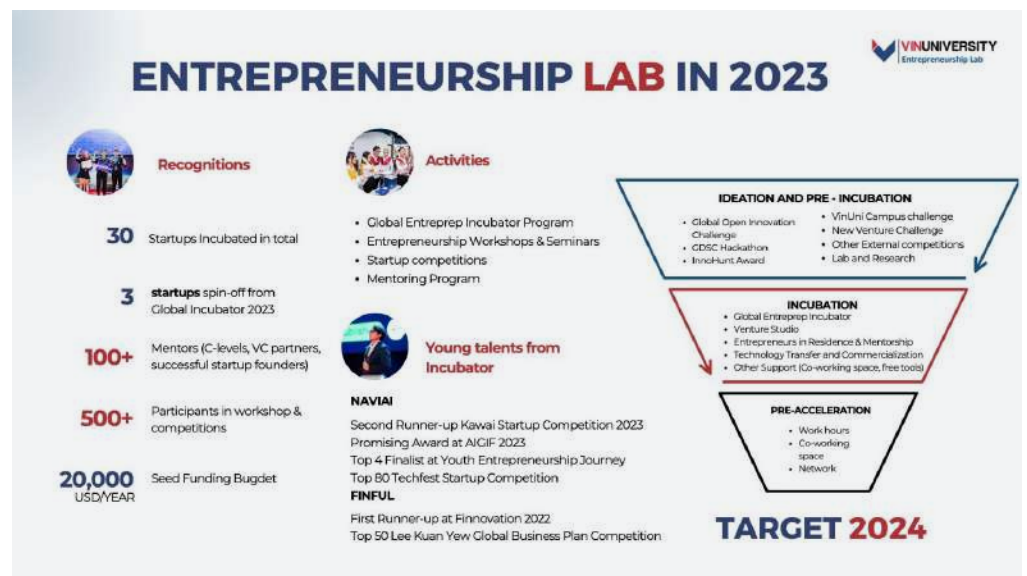

## Global Experience

VinUni has become a global education partner with 41 top universities worldwide, engaging 112 students in student exchange programs. Notably, 15 third-year undergraduate students have been admitted to pursue their Master's degrees at renowned institutions such as the University of Pennsylvania, Cornell University (Top 20 globally), UIUC (USA), University of Technology Sydney (UTS), and the University of Queensland (UQ). This unprecedented achievement in Vietnamese universities underscores the acknowledgment of VinUni's commitment to delivering high-quality education.

### Outbound exchange

A total of 59 students participated in exchange programs at 15 partner universities, including leading research institutions, of which 43% (5/15) are ranked in the top 50 globally, and 71% (10/15) are in the top 100. The distribution across Colleges is as follows:

- ▶ CECS: 24 students (41%)
- ▶ CBM: 29 students (49%)
- ▶ CHS: 6 students (10%)

Out of 56 students, 44% received financial support ranging from 30 to 90 million VND during their time abroad. Additionally, 22% of students received financial assistance ranging from 45 to 425 million VND from partner universities.

### Inbound exchange

A total of 75 students from Cornell University, Singapore Management University (SMU), the University of Utah, Cambridge University, the University of British Columbia (UBC), and the University of Pennsylvania participated in the exchange program at VinUni.

### Integrated Degree Programs

We have signed cumulative agreements for 12 collaborative training programs, facilitating seamless progression from Bachelor's to Master's degrees in the 3+2 or 4+1 model with top international universities:

- ▶ University of Pennsylvania (USA), ranked #13 globally by QS 2023.
- ▶ University of California San Diego (USA), ranked #34 globally by Times Higher Education 2022.
- ▶ University of Technology Sydney (Australia), ranked #11 among young universities worldwide - QS ranking 2022 (2 agreements).
- ▶ University of Queensland (Australia), ranked #47 globally by QS World University Ranking 2022, and #3 in Australia according to USNews 2022.
- ▶ Cornell University (USA), ranked #20 globally by QS 2023 (3 agreements).
- ▶ University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (USA), ranked #4 in postgraduate engineering and #3 in Environmental Engineering by US News 2022 (2 agreements).
- ▶ Nanyang Technological University (NTU), ranked #26 globally by QS - agreement signed in December 2023.

27 students have received invitations to enroll in the integrated 3+2 training program from the University of Pennsylvania, University of Technology Sydney (UTS), Cornell University, and the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, with 10 students awarded Vingroup 1.100 Scholarships.





## Career Readiness

In a concerted effort to enhance the overall student experience, VinUni took significant strides in fostering career readiness among its students through a series of impactful workshops and personalized guidance sessions. The Career Readiness Workshop Series comprised three well-attended workshops, each designed to address specific aspects of professional development. Workshop 1, focused on job applications and career paths, drew over 100 students, featuring insights from four distinguished guest speakers. Workshop 2 delved into CVs, cover letters, and online tests, with eight guest speakers engaging over 70 students. The third workshop, covering interviews, assessment centers, and group exercises, featured six speakers, including four industry leaders and two outstanding students who secured job offers from leading corporations.

These workshops have equipped students with practical knowledge, confidence, and crucial professional skills essential for navigating the complexities of the professional world. 32 students secured work placements offers from reputable companies after successful applications and interviews.

## Community Engagement

### Student Community-Engaged Projects

Cornell and VinUniversity students conducted research on adverse childhood experiences (ACE) in Vietnam, supporting the Vietnamese non-governmental organization Center for Supporting Community Development Initiatives (SCDI). The project began in the winter of 2021-2022 (held virtually) and continued during the summer of 2022 (virtually plus in-person in Hanoi, Vietnam). A third cohort of students continued this project working with SCDI and focusing on ACE in the summer 2023.

### VinUnion - connecting the Vinsers

VinUnion stands as the inaugural student club bridging students from VinUni and Vinschool with a mission to nurture leadership, empathy, exceptional abilities, creativity, entrepreneurial mindset, and leadership skills. Throughout 2023, VinUnion has made notable strides, issuing 2,400 boarding passes to VinUni and Vinschool, receiving 228 applications, and welcoming 89 official members. Engaging in 14 activities, VinUnion's reach extended to 80,000 people on social networks. The club successfully raised 200 million VND and additional assets, providing support to over 2,700 students and 30 families facing challenges. Highlighted activities include three community service projects in Lang Son, Thai Nguyen, and Phu Tho, involving 300 VinUnians and Vinsers. VinUnion also organized the first VinUni - Vinschool Football Championship, featuring over 200 students, and hosted the inaugural Miracle Christmas Charity Fair at VinUni, attracting 700 guests and 23 participating brands and companies. VinUnion facilitated a company visit to the VinFast factory in Haiphong, mentored by the Deputy CEO of VinFast. Additionally, the club organized various admission activities, such as college application workshops, "One Day as VinUnian," and team-building events encompassing sports and DIY workshops for both VinUnians and Vinsers.



## Digital Student Experience

To improve the digital experience for students, VinUni introduced two new platforms, namely the Global Exchange Platform and the Career Service Management System. These systems facilitate seamless online applications and evaluation processes for student exchange programs and simplify the process for students to explore job opportunities. Additionally, the official launch of the Student Success Platform marks a substantial advancement in enhancing the overall student experience. This newly developed platform offers a comprehensive view of student development and progress, functioning as a centralized online service hub. Students can conveniently access essential platforms, including SIS, Canvas LMS, Library, and the Career Service Portal, consolidating critical services for a more streamlined experience.

# Innovation Highlights

## Vietnam Industry Innovation Research

The Vietnam Industry Innovation Research (VIIR), a joint initiative between VinUniversity, the Portulans Institute, and Professor Soumitra Dutta, Dean of the Saïd Business School at the University of Oxford, aims to enhance the evaluation of innovation in Vietnam by providing a comprehensive perspective on industry innovation. As the first project of its kind in Southeast Asia and the sole initiative in Vietnam that comprehensively assessing industry innovation, VIIR garnered acclaim and commendation from policymakers, business leaders, and university representatives.



## Vietnam Industry Innovation Index Kick-off

Following the success of the Vietnam Industry Innovation Research Symposium held on June 14, 2023, the official kick-off ceremony for Vietnam Industry Innovation Index was organized under the guidance and professional sponsorship of the Ministry of Science and Technology as well as technical support from the University of Oxford and the Portulans Institute on December 21, 2023. Attended by the deputy minister, leaders of the Ministry of Science and Technology, and representatives from businesses and universities, the kick-off ceremony was executed with great success. The initiative promises to provide government departments with a valuable tool for assessing innovation, offering new prospects for advancement.

## MOU signing ceremony between State Agency for Technology Innovation, Ministry of Science and Technology and VinUniversity

On December 21, after the successful kick-off ceremony for Vietnam Industry Innovation Index, VinUni and the State Agency for Technology Innovation (SATI) officially signed a memorandum of understanding with the purpose to promote innovation activities, cultivate high-quality human resources in science, technology, and innovation, and construct sets of innovation indicators. This event served as an important milestone in the partnership between VinUni and SATI, as well as a critical step in the direction of coordinating efforts with the Ministry of Science and Technology to develop resources for the science and technology industry in Vietnam.





## City Branding Index

In 2023, the Place Branding Assessment Research (PBAR), a joint initiative between VinUniversity and Professor David Reibstein of the Wharton Business School, University of Pennsylvania, delivered notable outcomes. The project's initial phase involved surveying over 4,000 global citizens to evaluate 10 cities across 6 ASEAN countries, providing a broad perspective on city branding. The research provides valuable insights into the global perception of these cities, offering a clear understanding of their standing in the international community based on the key development dimensions. These findings serve as a crucial tool for city leaders and policymakers to make informed decisions aimed at strategic growth and development, helping cities enhance their global reputation and economic prospects. This dataset could support VinUni in future consultancy projects.



## White paper: Challenges & Prospects for Young Talents

The White Paper is a research initiative that delves into employers' expectations for talented graduates and seeks valuable insights into the perspectives of these graduates regarding the skills and behaviors crucial for successful employment and career development. After rigorous research and evaluation, a comprehensive report has been meticulously crafted. Drawing insights from surveys encompassing 344 students and 35 representatives from prominent companies in Vietnam, the report illuminates the disparity between salary expectations and employer willingness to pay. This report stands as a valuable resource for young talents and various stakeholders, including universities, employers, and parents. Its insights contribute significantly to advancing Vietnam's standing in the global talent landscape by offering actionable recommendations for skills development, innovative pedagogy promotion, and the creation of job opportunities with competitive compensation.

## Reimagine gifted and talented education (RE\*GATE)

The RE\*GATE 2023 (Reimagine Gifted & Talented Education Summit) significantly advanced gifted and talented education in Vietnam. By empowering educators with impactful innovations, the summit provided valuable insights for the benefit of gifted students. Its vision is to cultivate a global educational community committed to talent identification and enhancing educational programs for transformative students.

Held on July 26, 2023, with Professor Thomas Hatch from Columbia University as the keynote speaker, Dr Le Mai Lan – VinUniversity President, Dr Nguyen Chi Hieu – IEG Co-founder and CEO, and Mr Danielle Ruelle – VinUniversity Director of Teaching and Learning Excellence Center as the lecturers, the Summit attracted 120 educators out of 140 participants.





### Talented Educator Network (TEN)

The Talent Educators Network Workshop, held during Vinfuture Prize Week, was a dynamic event uniting member of the Talented Educator Network (TEN). Following the successful REGATE launch in July 2023, the workshop brought together pioneering educators in Vietnam and esteemed Vinfuture Awards Council members. Participants collaborated on innovative and inspirational discussions, focusing on talent development, advanced pedagogy, and the positive impact of educators on learners. The Talent Educators Conference attracted over 100 high school teachers, including approximately 15 Provost/Vice Provost from prestigious schools such as Hanoi Amsterdam, Yen Hoa, Nguyen Sieu, Vinschool, Newton, Dewey, Doan Thi Diem, Marie Curie, and more. There were 32 nominated initiatives, and 10 micro-innovations were selected for presentation. VinUni played a pivotal role as the Hub for Innovative Education.

### VAIPE project - an AI and IoT Application for Smart Healthcare

The VAIPE project - an AI and IoT application for smart healthcare for Vietnamese individuals - received the AI Awards 2022 and made it to the shortlist for the QS Reimagine Award in the Power of Partnerships category. VAIPE collects, manages, and analyzes personal health data, automatically identifies medications from pill images, and tracks medication usage habits and health indices. The gathered information is analyzed to provide recommendations for safe medication usage, alert against medication errors, and assist in early diagnosis of illnesses.



### 3D Technology Center in Medicine

The 3D Technology Center in Medicine has secured an exclusive patent for the personalized surgical navigation device manufacturing process, marking the first and only application of 3D technology in healthcare in Vietnam. Exceeding targets, the center has completed 131/120 cases using 3D joint bone material technology in surgery, with the product undergoing commercialization for deployment at Vinmec. Additionally, the center obtained ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 13485:2016 certifications for its quality management system; and successfully registered patent "The process for manufacturing personalized surgical navigation devices" with Intellectual Property Office.

Furthermore, the center's product, the "Personalized Surgical Navigation Device using 3D Printing Technology," clinched the top spot in the Medical Technovation 2022 competition. This groundbreaking product enables precise surgical navigation, boasting 98% accuracy and minimizing unnecessary trauma during procedures. This innovative technology is a first in Vietnam and has not been publicly researched globally.

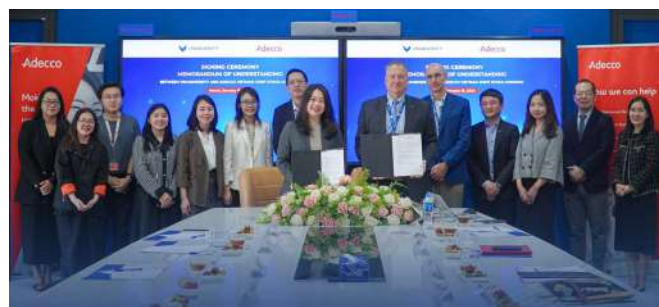

University-industry collaboration plays a crucial role in VinUni's development strategy. Through mutually beneficial relationships with highly-regarded companies and organizations locally and globally, VinUni aims to provide our students with valuable, distinctive internship and employment opportunities that help develop their professionalism, conduct and network, and enhance their employability.



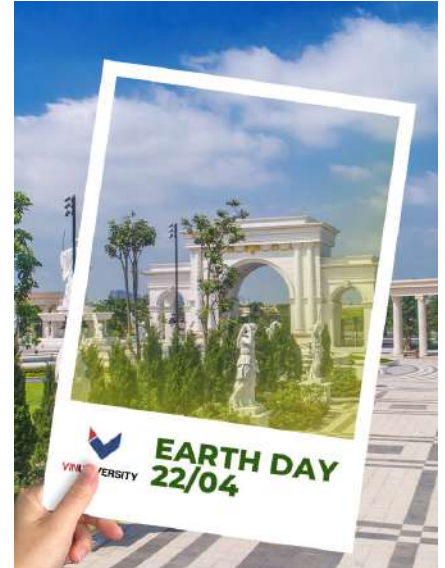
To that end, VinUni has established partnerships with reputable partners such as Ernst & Young Vietnam, 108 Military Central Hospital, Vietnam National Children's Hospital, and several companies and research institutes under the Vingroup ecosystem such as Vinmec, VinBigData, VinAI, VinBrain, HMS and others. To date, 37 MOUs at University levels have been signed to support students' internships and career opportunities. VinUni also launched the Career Service Management Platform, where industry partners can post internships and job opportunities, and students can apply via the Platform after VinUni Colleges and Career Services approve the postings.



# Social Activities and Campus Sustainability

## Awards

VinUni is the first university in Vietnam to be honored with the ISCN Excellence Award 2023 for the project "Initiative for the Development and Provision of Globally Accessible Smart Healthcare Solutions". This is an international award for sustainable development presented by the International Sustainable Campus Network (ISCN). The award, held annually, aims to recognize outstanding contributions of universities worldwide in promoting significant sustainable programs, projects, and initiatives that have a substantial impact on the community.



## Environmental Responsibility

VinUni allocates 84% of its construction density to landscaping and greenery. Additionally, the university has installed a rooftop solar energy system covering a total area of 1,000 square meters, providing an average of 600 kWh per day and achieving a total energy generation of over 163.8 thousand kW. Furthermore, the university has invested in a direct water dispensing system across the campus, along with a water filling station equipped with a display showing the reduced number of plastic bottles released into the environment. Over the course of four years since its establishment, this initiative has helped minimize the disposal of over 500 thousand plastic bottles at VinUni.

## Responsibility to Partners, Learners, and the Community

VinUni continues to implement the **1,100 Vingroup Science and Technology Scholarships program**. After nearly 5 years of execution, the program has seen 50 students successfully complete their Master's degrees. Among them, 20 have continued their studies to pursue Ph.D. degrees with scholarships from external sources. Ten individuals are gaining practical experience by working at prominent companies and corporations such as JP Morgan Chase and Global Energies before returning to Vietnam. The remaining students have completed the program and returned to Vietnam, taking on roles as lecturers, researchers at domestic universities and major research institutes, or becoming experts and engineers in various businesses across the country. This commitment reflects VinUni's dedication to nurturing talent and contributing to the development of the academic and professional landscape in Vietnam.

In addition, the program has established the **Vingroup Global Young Scholars**

**Network** with nearly 180 talented members sponsored through scholarships. This network forms a community of young intellectuals working together to overcome academic challenges, striving to contribute to scientific advancements beyond national boundaries and reaching global prominence. In 2023 alone, the program awarded 40 scholarships to young talents pursuing Master's, Ph.D., and postdoctoral studies, with a total value of 12 billion VND. Among these, there were 23 Master's scholarships, 15 Ph.D. scholarships, and 2 postdoctoral scholarships, distributed across various fields of basic science and technology such as Data Science, Computer Science and Information Technology, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Robotics, and Biomedical Engineering.

In 2023, VinUni continued the implementation of the **English communication** accessibility project for the people of Khanh Hoa province. The target audience includes students, workers who interact with foreign tourists, small business owners,

government officials, and employees in state agencies. As of now, VinUni has established 172 clubs with 1,500 members actively participating.

Beyond contributions to the university's community, VinUni students have created the **Young Change Maker and UpYouth** information portals to equip young people with professional knowledge, business insights, career guidance, and entrepreneurial skills. These platforms also inspire young individuals to confidently connect with industry advisors and startup mentors to pursue their dreams. Specifically, students have provided career guidance to 12,091 high school students, directly assisting 3,930 students offline in topics such as time management, information seeking, problem-solving, knowledge about professions and career trends in Vietnam, English language classes, art classes, self-defense skills for female students, and more. Online guidance was provided for 8,161 students through counselor class platforms on the website, skills-focused videos, industry reports, and more.

- ▶ Prof. Phuoc Le, Vice Dean of the College of Health Sciences, surpassed more than 30,000 candidates to be honored with the prestigious Community Service Award - Edison T. Uno Chancellor Awards from the University of California, San Francisco, USA, to recognize contributions from professors in the field of public health care, associated with the establishment of a network HEAL (Health, Equity, Action, and Leadership). This is a 2-year intensive training project for more than 200 doctors with the orientation of providing medical care to poor communities in rural areas and priority areas in the world.



- ▶ The research project "Learning Disabilities among Medical and Nursing Students in Vietnam: A Knowledge, Attitude, and Practice (KAP) study" officially received internal funding of US\$ 25,000 via the Fast-track program. The project is led by Dr Le Van Phuoc (PI) and Dr Pranee Liamputtong (Co-PI), along with internal and external consultants and coordinators, and four medical and nursing student research assistants. The research will be conducted at nationwide universities. This is the first project ever to look at how students at university level think and act upon the topic of learning disabilities. The research outcomes will be to determine a key gap in the understanding and perceptions about learning disabilities in Vietnam, and hopefully lead to improved services and inclusive education to not only VinUni students but also students across the country.



- ▶ Prof. Le Cu Linh, Prof. Nguyen Thi Hoa Huyen, Prof. Hoang Lan Van and colleagues published an article reviewing scientific literature on the extent to which consumption of sugary drinks increases the risk of metabolic syndrome in adults in the journal Clinical Nutrition Espen.





- Prof. Pham Huy Hieu, a lecturer at the College of Engineering and Computer Science and Deputy Director of VinUni-Illinois Smart Health Center, has just been honored as one of top 10 young scientists who won the Golden Globe Award 2023 for Science and Technology. Prof. Hieu was also appointed as a member of the National Academy of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine (NASEM) Research Innovation Workshop on Neuroscience in Southeast Asia.



- Research team of Prof. Pham Huy Hieu won the Best Paper award at the 11th International Conference on Computers and Networks held in Matsue, Japan.



- The project "SMART CEM - Application of artificial intelligence and visual attention monitoring devices to design and manage excellent customer experiences in the hotel industry," led by Prof. Le Thi Phuong Dung, received sponsorship from the VinIF fund with an expected total sponsorship of 4,000,000,000 VND.

- The book "Service Marketing" co-authored by Prof. Le Thi Phuong Dung, Prof. Phi Thi Linh Giang, Prof. Rohit Verma, Prof. Rochen Writz, and Prof. Christopher Lovelock, was released and introduced at the Excellent Service Workshop organized by VinUni and CSMO.



- Prof. Andrew Taylor Robinson has been officially appointed as a Fellow of The Royal College of Physicians (FRCP), the oldest medical university in the United Kingdom (established in 1518). The appointment recognizes his outstanding and continuous contributions to medicine as a non-medical scholar.





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
