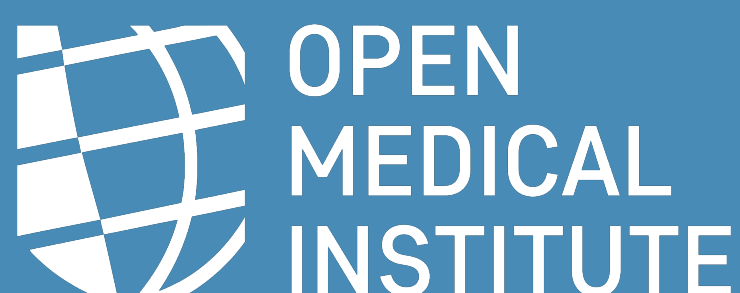

The Open Medical Institute (OMI) presents a seminar in Pediatric Emergency Medicine in collaboration with VinUniversity and the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP). This three and a half-day course will be led by experts from the world-renowned CHOP, targets physicians who care for children with medical, surgical, and traumatic emergencies. It is also valuable for general physicians, pediatricians, emergency physicians, critical care physicians, and anesthesiologists. The seminar consists of lectures, case discussions, case presentations, as well as a simulation training that provides an exciting hands-on experience.



TOPICS COVERED INCLUDE

Status epilepticus, pediatric airway management and intubation, head trauma, headache, asthma, syncope, abdominal emergencies, and the approach to ill neonates and infants. By the end of the course, participants will be trained in new diagnostic approaches, differential diagnoses, therapeutic interventions, procedural, and management skills.

APPLICATIONS REQUIREMENTS

Fellows **must be fluent in English**, have either **completed their specialisation** or are in the **final phase of their residency**, and **plan to pursue a professional career in their home country**.

The seminar is limited to a maximum of 30 participants. This allows for intense interaction during lectures, discussions, case presentations, and hands-on training sessions. All OMI fellows must contribute academically by presenting an interesting case study. Attendance is mandatory for the entire course.
