



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF FOR A WEEK EXCHANGE IN THE UNIVERSITAT POLITÈCNICA DE VALÈNCIA (SPAIN)

VinUniversity and the Universitat Politècnica de València (Spain) agreed to cooperate on the exchange of students and staff in the context of the Erasmus+KA171 program.

This is an excellent opportunity for you not only to build on your existing skills, create networking with staff from other universities in the same field, but also experience different culture and work environment. This program provides a grant for 1 VinUni staff to study for one week organized by UPV.

To whom: Full-time academic/administrative staff of VinUniversity

Where to: Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV).

What for: The administrative staff will participate in the Staff Weeks organized by UPV.

Period of the stay in the UPV: One week (five working days and two travel days) according to the Staff week calendar.

Grant: €2,620 (including €1,500 for travel and €160 per day x 7 days for Total scholarship)

Eligible staff:

- Full-time academic/administrative staff in the target group at <u>Staff week information</u> (please choose the training week program conducted at UPV).

- Have completed at least a year of working full time at the University.

- Have the support of your line manager in order to apply.

- Priority for those who have not had international exposure experience offered by VinUni during your time as a VinUni and have not previously received funding for professional development overseas by VinUni.

- Priority for those who involve with students support services, especially international student experience, to increase the student experience.

Applications Deadline: 6pm, 10 November 2023

Required Application Documents:

1. CV

2. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses why you wish to participate in this exchange, overall objectives of the mobility, and expected outcomes on the professional development.

3. Other supporting documents (Awards/Achievements during your time as a VinUni staff,

passports/residence card, etc.)

4. Letter of Recommendation

5. Administrative staff: Point out the staff week offered by UPV of your interest at: HERE

Selection Criteria

The selection committee will consider the following criteria:

1. Applicant's curriculum vitae: up to 2 points

2. Motivation letter: up to 3 points

3. Awards and achievements: up to 5 points

4. Proposed work plan: up to 4 points. This section will take into account the added value of mobility (for both institutions and for the participant) and the expected impact and results

Nominated applicants who pass the selection process of the VinUni Selection Committee will then make another application to UPV. UPV will make the final admission decision. Information about that application round will be communicated to the shortlisted applicants later.
