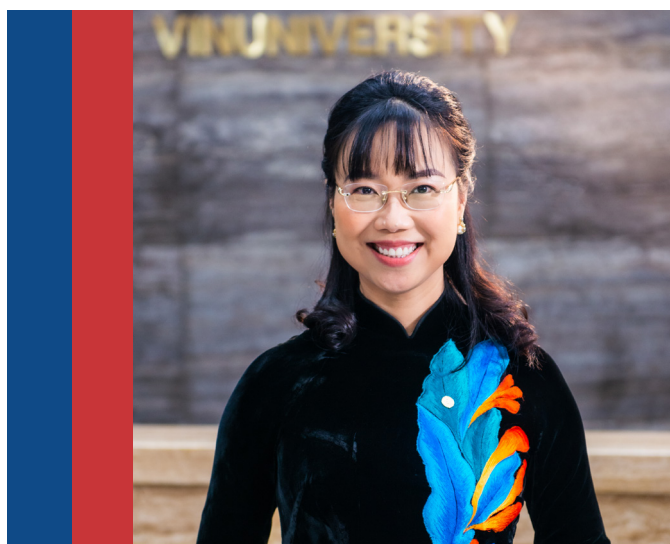
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# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

**VINUNIVERSITY**

VinUniversity (VinUni) is an excellent, private, not-for-profit university established by Vingroup. VinUni aspires to develop talents for the future, to make a breakthrough in Vietnam higher education and to become a world-class university.

With the goal of becoming one of the top 50 young universities of the world, VinUni has built strategic partnership with two of the world top 20 Universities, namely Cornell University and the University of Pennsylvania.

Established on the highest standards of research, teaching, career development and international outlook, within the first year, VinUniversity was awarded Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) 5 stars rating for three aspects: Facilities, Academic Development and Inclusiveness. The institution also signs collaboration agreements to offer integrated dual-degree with universities leading in computer science, technology, business management and health sciences.

VinUniversity's inauguration ceremony was held on its campus located at Vinhomes Ocean Park, Gia Lam, Hanoi, with a total investment of VND 6,500 billions (approximately USD 285 millions) from Vingroup.

The institution comprises of Faculty of Arts and Sciences; College of Business and Management; College of Engineering and Computer Science; and College of Health Sciences. It currently offers 10 degree programs, namely:

- Bachelor of Business Administration; Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management
- Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering; Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering; Bachelor of Science in Computer Science
- Bachelor of Nursing; Medical Doctor Program; Internal Medicine Residency Program; General Surgery Residency Program; Pediatrics Residency Program



# FOUNDING DONOR



VinUniversity was founded by Vingroup Joint Stock Company (Vingroup JSC) as a private, not-for-profit university for the purpose of fostering and developing talents for the future.

Vingroup, formerly known as Technocom Corporation, was founded in 1993 in Ukraine. In the early 2000s, Vingroup started in Vietnam with two key brands: Vincom and Vinpearl. In January 2012, Vinpearl JSC merged with Vincom JSC to form Vingroup Joint Stock Company.

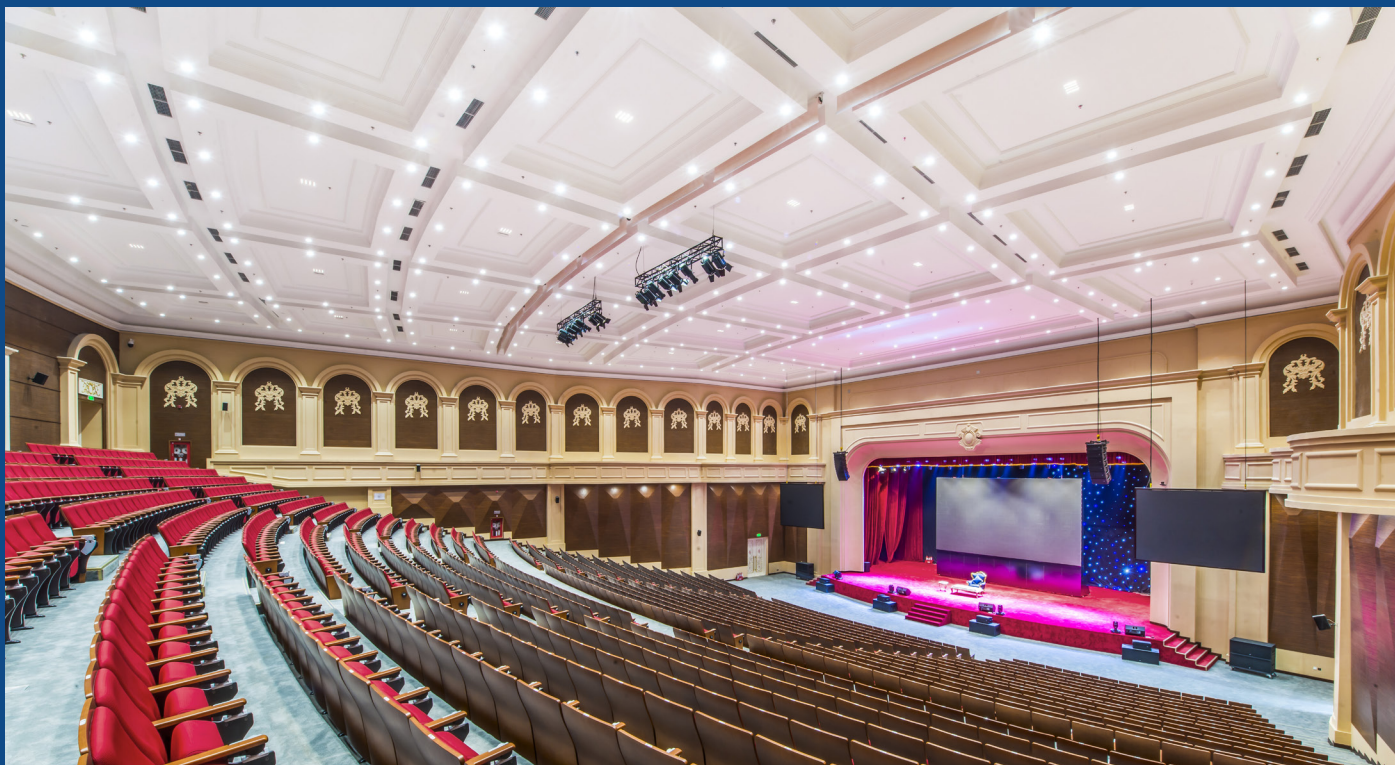
- Technology;

The entire curriculum, from design to quality validation, is supported by Cornell University and University of Pennsylvania.

### #3: Globally Distinguished Faculty

With the current student-to-faculty ratios at VinUniversity being 6:1, students have the chance to participate in research and write scientific publications

for prestigious journals alongside their highly qualified "captains", who possess in-depth work and research experience at leading universities around the globe.

### #4: World-class Standards

Every aspect of the University: its curricula, research, faculty, student body, facilities, and campus life, is being developed to meet the highest standards set by the world's leading accrediting and ranking organizations, such as ABET, AACSB, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) and Times Higher Education (THE). VinUniversity was granted QS 5-star standard certificate in three key areas: Facilities, Academic Development and Inclusiveness, immediately preceding the First Convocation.

#### **#5: Impressive First Year Experience**

OASIS program (Orientation, Advising, Study Skills, Intercultural Awareness and Self-exploration & Growth) is designed to transform a young high school student into a college student who is mature, proud, confident, independent, and capable of independent learning and self-control.

#### **#6: Integrated Bachelor's - Master's program**

VinUniversity has successfully reached cooperation agreements on the integrated Bachelor's - Master's program with leading global universities, giving students the opportunity to obtain Master's Degrees faster from:

- University of Pennsylvania, USA (ranked #13 globally, #1 in Nursing globally);
- Cornell University, USA (ranked #19 globally);
- University of California, San Diego, USA (ranked #33 globally);
- University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, USA (ranked #48 globally);
- University of Technology Sydney, Australia (ranked #11 among young universities globally).

#### **#7: Bridging the Gaps between Academic and Industry**

Besides equipping students with academic knowledge, VinUniversity has developed special learning and practical programs to prepare graduates for real-life challenges, with hands-on learning and real-world experience:

- The Entrepreneur Lab helps develop students' start-up ideas, and to provides them the opportunities to interact with and learn from renowned experts and entrepreneurs.
- Industry Mentorship Program where students are paired with an advisor to learn from their experience and get to know the particular industry sector.
- Summer Internship enables students to challenge themselves at more than 10 companies in the fields of finance, hospitality, technology, industry, start-ups, and so on.

#### **#8: Research for Humanity**

In 2020, 54 scientific papers by VinUniversity faculty have been published in prestigious academic journals. VinUniversity Provost, Vice Provost, and Dean of College of Health Sciences have been honored in the top 2% of the world's most cited scholars, according to the latest publication of PLOS Biology Journal (USA) in 2020. VinUniversity also funds its faculty's research projects in the form of "seed funding" to solve contemporary issues, making positive impact on society.

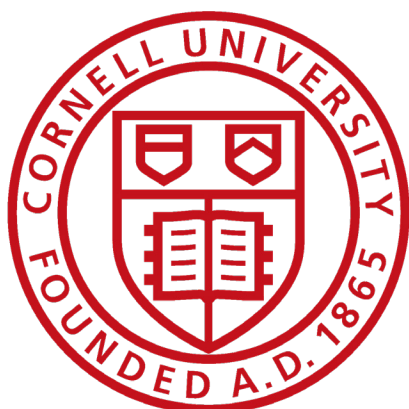

Cornell University's primary role is to build VinUni's faculty and academic leadership teams; to validate and assure the quality of the curricula developed by VinUniversity faculty; and to guide VinUniversity on a path towards international accreditations. Cornell faculty members provide advice to lay the foundation to position VinUniversity as a world-class teaching and research university in accordance with QS 5-star rating standards.

Since the beginning, Cornell University has been involved in every aspect of VinUniversity's development including infrastructure, governance, faculty, admissions, and curriculum development. The Cornell-VinUniversity Project Team has provided support in founding VinUniversity with the participation of 200 faculty and staff, who have flown 687,000 miles on 40 trips to reach Vietnam. To strengthen their commitment, Cornell approved a multi-year leave for Professor Rohit Verma (Dean of External Relations, Cornell SC Johnson College of Business and Singapore Tourism Board Distinguished Professor), to assume the responsibility of Founding Provost of VinUniversity.

Following the strategic cooperation between the two universities, in August 2020, Cornell University and VinUniversity signed an agreement on the student exchange program. This program allows Cornell students to spend their time at VinUniversity as exchange students starting from the 2021 spring semester. An equal number of VinUniversity students have the opportunity to study at Cornell University for the same duration. Students participating in the program will have their academic qualifications and study periods abroad recognized by both universities. This will also set the path for VinUniversity to discuss new projects, including dual degrees in both universities, with Cornell as well as other prestigious international universities.

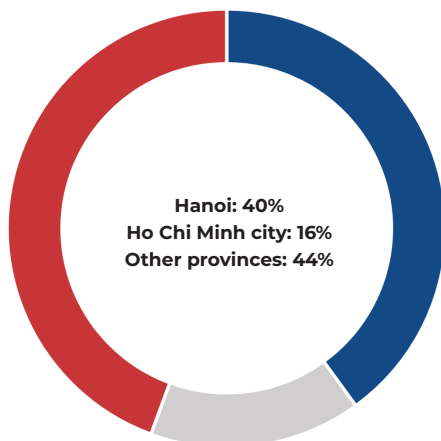

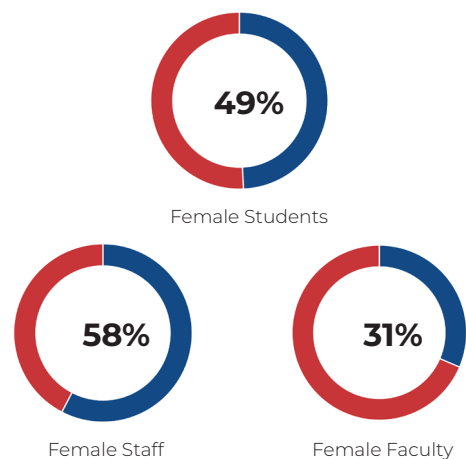

# KEY MILESTONES



## January 2020

VinUniversity Campus Opening Ceremony

## February 2020

The Minister of Education and Training of Vietnam granted the operating license officially allowing VinUniversity to offer academic programs.

## July 2020

The Vietnam's Ministry of Health approved for VinUni to offer the **Graduate Medical Education (GME) Programs**.

## September 2020

VinUniversity reached **agreements with Cornell University, University of Technology Sydney and Yonsei School of Business** on the exchanges of students offering opportunities for VinUni students to go for exchange at these universities.

VinUni initiated the **Study Away program** via that VinUni has hosted 30 students from Cornell University and the University of Technology Sydney (UTS) who were not able to travel to their home universities due to the pandemic.

## October 2020

Inaugural Orientation Week and **Convocation for Academic Year 2020-2021**.

Just before the Convocation, VinUni was honored to receive the **5-star rating by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)** on Academic Development, Facilities, and Inclusiveness on October 9th 2020.

## December 2020

VinUniversity reached agreements with reputable academic and corporate and partners in Vietnam as well as in the world in faculty exchange, internship, employment, and joint research: the University of California, San Diego, University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign, POSTECH, Ernst & Young Vietnam, 108 Military Central Hospital, Vietnam National Children's Hospital, and so on.

In the AY 2020-2021, VinUniversity continued to reach agreements with other leading universities such as Yonsei University, Seoul National University, Technion-Israel Institute of Technology, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne, Western University, University of Technology Sydney. VinUniversity has also signed cooperation agreement with Vingroup subsidiaries, namely Vinpearl, VinHMS, One Mount Group, VinBrain, Vinmec, VinBigdata, VinAI.

## February 2021

VinUni granted funding to 16 Seed-Funding projects in AY 2020-2021. Among these 16 projects, at least 13 projects involved international collaboration

## May 2021

VinUni's College of Business and Management established the Industry Advisory Board (IAB). The first 8 members of the IAB are all high-level leaders at leading corporations, including Chairwoman; Chief Executive Officer; Managing Director;... The College of Business and Management has offered many programs to give students the most comprehensive experience of the real professional work environment. These include Industry Speaker Series, Industry Mentorship Program, 5 in 5 Internship, Summer Internship, etc

## July 2021

VinUniversity Global Case Competition (VGCC) 2021 was officially launched. This is an annual competition organized by VinUniversity with support from Cornell University, in order to provide a platform for students to work on real-life problems.

Prior to VGCC 2021, VinUni has successfully held the Vietnamese Business Case Competition (VBCC 2021). VBCC has received applications from 300 teams of 120 different schools.

## August 2021

VinUniversity successfully reached cooperation agreements on the **integrated Bachelor's - Master's program** with University of Pennsylvania, Cornell University, University of California, San Diego, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, University of Technology Sydney, Australia.

### 5in5 Internship Program

This uniquely designed program offers students a chance to work at VinUniversity’s partner companies for a minimum of 40 hours over 5 weeks (5 days in 5 weeks). From the very first day, students are assigned into teams in order to work on a specific case study. Constant rotation between different departments during these 5 weeks aims to provide students with multi-disciplinary and multi-perspective understanding and assessment of the company. 3 partner companies this academic year 2020-21 were Vinpearl, VinHMS, and EY.

### Summer Internship Program

At CBM, we allow students to apply their talents and skills right from the first year of study. As such, this year we have collaborated with EY, Vinpearl, VinHMS, One Mount, SK Vietnam, and Mirae Asset Securities Vietnam, and brought a number of summer internship opportunities to students.

### Start-Up Internship Program

Unlike in traditional summer internships, each participating student is assigned an industry supervisor and a faculty member for the whole 8-week duration of the internship. In teams of 3-4, students are expected to solve real problems faced by the partner companies. We are privileged to work with Do Ventures and Nextrans to deliver this program.

### Industry Advisory Board (IAB)

IAB was established with 8 founding members from One Mount, Accor Group, Golden Gate Group, Got It, Boston Consulting Group (BCG), Talentnet, Deloitte, and Falcon Associates. This board will serve as the linking bridge between CBM’s strategic objectives and industry interests.

#### Research on How AI Application contributes to Hotel Innovation and Transformation – by Dr. Le Thi Phuong Dung, Assistant Professor

Dr. Le Thi Phuong Dung (Jenny), together with a first-year HM student, conducted research on the influence of socio-cultural differences on consumer decisions through an intensive analysis of generational gaps and educational and cultural values in Vietnam and Australia. ### Student Achievements

**Trinh Huu Gia Phuc**, a first-year CS student, developed an automatic evaluating system for programming coursework. The system is based on the open-source Contest Management System (CMS) platform. Using this system, students can receive grades and comments for their work immediately after submission and do not need to wait a few days for professors to grade.

**Vu Truong Giang**, a first-year CS student, won the third prize in the 29th Vietnam Olympiad in Informatics for Undergraduates at Can Tho University. "Studying at VinUniversity gave me the valuable opportunity to discover myself. The workload is challenging, but there are always friends who will help you out when you need it".

**Tran Huong Lan, Vu Truong Giang, Nguyen Thai Hung,** and **Nguyen Dinh Cuong** won the 3rd prize in the 2020 International Collegiate Programming Contest (ICPC) Vietnam Northern & Central Provincial Contest.

**Tran Tue Nhi** won 1st prize in the KPMG's Global Creative Ideas Competition, Vietnam-Cambodia Region

**Nguyen Minh Tuan** and **Tran Tuan Viet**, two first-year CS students, developed the Financial Calculator app to calculate the total estimated costs for an academic year at VinUniversity.

**Mai Quang Tuan** and **Pham Quang Bach** were selected into the final round of RMIT's Fintech Blockchain contest.

**VinMaker Club** organized the STEAM festival for more than 8,000 students at the Vietnam International Innovation Expo 2021 organized by the Ministry of Planning and Investment.

## Research Highlights

### Research on Mobile Application Development for Diagnosing Cardiovascular Diseases – by Dr. Do Danh Cuong

Together with first-year student Phan Nhat Huy as his research assistant, Dr. Cuong has worked on developing a signal rhythm screening algorithm that can detect abnormalities in an electrocardiogram.

Huy shared: *“I had no experience creating standardization frameworks for experiments by myself, so I had a lot of pressure to get it right the first time. But above all, my independent studies and research have enabled me to absorb a larger pool of knowledge more effectively.”*

### Research on Optimized LED Lights Development for Electric Cars – by Dr. Le Van Quynh

Dr. Quynh’s team is attempting to integrate new generation LED lights with metamaterial and quantum dot nanophotonic structure, allowing nanometer-precise customization of light attributes such as direction, optimized brightness contrast, and angular color shifting. The research is conducted under an on-going collaboration with the Institute of Materials Science, Vietnam National University, as well as international institutions such as Boston University (United States), École Centrale de Lyon, and University of Paris (France). 3 first-year students, namely Le Viet Hoang, Le Nu Uyen Phuong, and Tran Gia Khanh also assisted with this project.

*“I was assigned to research computing algorithms to propose the most energy-efficient and high-performance nanophotonic structure. Other research assistants focused on device operations in the lab environment to test the structure. It was a truly enjoyable experience,”* Le Nu Uyen Phuong revealed.

### Research on Privacy-Preserving Data for Autonomous Vehicles – by Professor Kok-seng Wong

Dr. Kok-Seng Wong, together with 5 CECS students, Vu Hong Phuc, Vu Truong Giang, Nguyen Thai Hung, Tran Huong Lan, and Nguyen Minh Tuan, is working on data anonymization and cryptography via basic encryption schemes such as Paillier or El Gamal, in order to protect autonomous vehicle owners’ personal information.

### Undergraduate Programs

#### Bachelor of Nursing (BN) program

**Extensive student experience is the top highlight of the nursing program**

- Student survey shows all nursing professional courses were rated at nearly maximum scores (5/5) for both faculty and course content criteria.
- The teaching and learning activities were enriched by active learning strategies and state-of-the-art technologies such as Pirogov Interactive Anatomy table and Simulation center.

#### Professional exposure:

- During the first semester, students went to Vinmec hospital for an early immersion in the clinical environment.
- In order to help students to think like a nurse and act like a nurse, besides class activities, students were provided with the opportunity to connect with six top Vietnamese nurses, working domestically and internationally, via open dialogs.



#### Research activities:

- Nursing faculty published 6 research articles. One book was completed and is in the process of being published. All four faculty members are active reviewers for international and national nursing journals.
- They also received one seed grant from VinUni and one other research grant from ChildFund-Australia.
- 60% of our students are engaged in research activities and are assisting faculty on their research projects through the Work-Study Program.

The program has a strong focus on clinical practice. With jobs guaranteed at Vinmec for students right after graduation, VinUni's Nursing program stands out among others.

#### Medical Doctor (MD) Program

The six-year MD Program is designed to develop future leaders in healthcare for local and global needs in collaboration with University of Pennsylvania. The

program aims to graduate doctors who are good Clinicians with sound knowledge, Professionals who put patients first, and Researchers who constantly look for best evidence in Medicine. This is what we call CPR – an acronym that every health professional knows



#### Academic Highlights

- Year One started with basic science subjects to provide foundational knowledge. The students are expected to act as professionals from year one, and therefore professionalism as a theme is introduced early on along with research. An orientation about the research process started with phrasing the research questions and literature review. A symposium at the end of semester one allowed 49 enrolled students to present their findings. The process continued with a mock ethics committee to understand the ethical aspects of research and professionalism.
- In the second semester, students were required to use their imagination to demonstrate professional attributes. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the face-to-face exhibition was replaced with an online digital event on LinkedIn® to show case students' work.
- To keep in line with contemporary trends, students have started creating their own e-portfolios from week one with digital stories, and documenting transitions from one phase to another with learning plans. This is a first of its kind practice in Viet Nam. Regular panel discussions with patients, care givers, and experts from various clinical/non-clinical fields provided students with additional insights into the profession.
- Students are represented on every committee established for the governance of the MD Program. In addition, all female students are also offered a membership to the Medical Women International Association.
- As we move to the second year, the teaching will focus on pre-clinical sciences and early clinical experiences within simulated environments and the introduction of the Longitudinal Mentoring Program.

## Achievement Highlights

### VinUniversity Medical Simulation Center (VMSC)

VinUniversity is the first and only higher education institution in Vietnam that uses the Simboost system, which is designed to provide video-based debriefing, manage training schedules/resources, and support post-training evaluation. For the Academic Year 2020-2021, VMSC has successfully provided simulation courses and issued 845 certificates to learners, including 306 AHA certificates to students and staff, 404 to Vinmec professionals, and 135 to other external learners. Other highlights include:

- Two-day **Communication Skills TOT** for 9 CHS faculty and staff in October and November 2020.
- Renewed licenses for 13 **Basic Life Support (BLS)** instructors (valid until October 2022) and 8 **Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)** instructors (valid until June 2023).
- The **International Training Center (ITC)** agreement with American Heart Society (AHA) was successfully renewed for another 3 years (valid until May 2024).
- Completed the setup and deployed successfully the Medical Gas, Audio Visual, and Simboost simulation management system in training sessions.

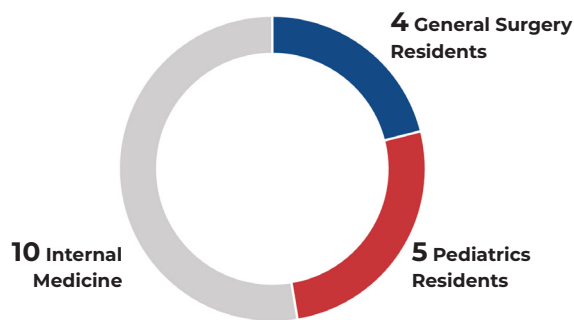
### Student Highlight

### Graduate Medical Education (GME) Program

**3 Residency programs offered for the first time in Vietnam by a newly established private higher education institution in affiliation with a not-for-profit private healthcare system**

#### Academic Highlights:

- VinUniversity Graduate Medical Education (GME) program had a ground-breaking academic year 2020-2021. The inaugural GME recruitment cycle included the administration of the International Foundations of Medicine (IFOM) exam to all 3 residency programs — the first internationally-benchmarked exam to be translated, validated, and administered in Vietnamese. The successful organization of IFOM — which is developed by the US National Board of Medical Examiners (NBME), the same founder of USMLE steps that certified medical students and residents in the U.S. — shows the commitment to world-class quality from VinUniversity to our talented students.
- The recruitment cycle concluded in early September with an outstanding cohort of residents hailing from all over Vietnam, including ten residents in Internal Medicine, five residents in Pediatrics, and four residents in General Surgery.
- In the first semester, the residents completed

the Penn-developed Core Clinical Skills course. This novel, concentrated resident preparation curriculum includes lectures, workshops, simulation activities, and a longitudinal preceptorship at Vinmec Times City International Hospital. At the conclusion of this course, the residents completed the first Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) administered at the VinUniversity Simulation Center.

#### Professional Exposure:

In March, the residents began full-time clinical rotations at Vinmec Times City International Hospital. They continued their rapid development through daily involvement in patient care under the supervision of the affiliate clinical faculty and the GME program directors and associate program directors.

Clinical faculty development has progressed significantly, with the GME team delivering additional sessions of the Master Clinical Educator Academy (MCEA) Part 1 curriculum, which will be followed by the newly developed curriculum of MCEA Part 2. Agreements have been made with key partner public hospitals, National Children's Hospital and Military Hospital 108. Implementation plans will be finalized in the summer of 2021.

## Research Highlights

### Research on Immune System Measuring: a Study on Patients with Infections and Cancer – by Professor Huynh Dinh Chien

Together with a resident doctor, Nguyen Duy Nghia, and 2 first-year students, Vinh Bao Tuan and Luu Bao Linh, Professor Nguyen Dinh Chien is building an aggregated database as the foundation for effective measurement of patients' immune system towards early research-based diagnoses for septicemia patients as well as colorectal cancer patients.

Luu Bao Linh noted: *"I now realize that healthcare professions cannot rely solely on doctors' medical knowledge, but it also requires close collaboration between science and technology. I have gained valuable knowledge about Machine Learning/Deep Learning, which I have never imagined having the opportunity to learn about since I'm a medical student".*

### Research on Postpartum Depression – by Dr. Nguyen Thi Hoa Uyen and Dr. Nguyen Thi Thanh Huong

Along with 2 first-year BN students, CHS faculty members are working on a project that will help women and their families overcome the challenges of postpartum depression and avoid negative health outcomes for both the mothers and the newborns.

## Events

### White Coat Ceremony

On the very same day of our Convocation, College of Health Sciences hosted its first White Coat Ceremony for all inaugural MD and BN students. The true meaning of healthcare professions and the future responsibilities that students carry forward for their patients and families were emphasized. All students, faculty members, and honorary guests took the Hippocratic Oath – Declaration of Geneva adaption following the long-standing tradition of medical students, before embarking on their official journey of becoming healthcare professionals. Vietnam's Deputy Minister of Health, Professor Tran Van Thuan, also joined the ceremony as the keynote speaker.

### Study-Away Program

This is a short-term exchange opportunity offered exclusively for international students who experienced difficulties returning to their home countries and universities during the COVID-19 pandemic. Students from Cornell University, USA, and University of Technology Sydney, Australia (UTS) called VinUniversity home for a semester under the Program. In March 2021, VinUniversity continued to extend the warmest welcome to students from Cornell University, UTS University, and EHL University – Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne, Switzerland to enroll in the spring semester. A total of 50 students were hosted by FAS this year.

### Key Achievement

FAS taught every single VinUniversity student (1,500+ participants) through a large number of classes in the AY20-21, with approximately 23 Humanities, Arts & Social Sciences classes; 19 Academic English classes; 5 Pathway English classes; 3 elective courses; over 25 Healthy Lifestyle classes, and a number of sessions on OASIS. A special course called Vietnam Discovery was custom-designed for Study Away students from our partner Universities, totaling 3,500 teaching hours (including in-class, tutorials, office hours), which is equivalent to 8,000-9,000 hours of preparation, feedback, and student consultations. We also successfully delivered the Pathway program to help over 30 students improve their English to start in Fall semester, and the Academic English program as 1st year language support.

Development of 20+ subjects with full teaching materials followed the standard quality assurance process (application of Co-Design Workshops to create and validate all FAS courses with external experts in the field).

**Active learning with student-centered approach** was adopted and implemented across all FAS disciplines, e.g. application of team-based learning, project-based learning, game-based learning, experiential learning, application of technology into teaching, personalized and tutorial approach, successful transformation of government-mandated ideology subjects into multi-angle and active learning ones with fieldwork trips to expose students to real societal conditions.

**Students' transformation** going from high-school into a university environment: students learnt new life skills – from self-administration to caring for others and living and working full-time in student dormitories and on campus, became more confident and competent in speech and writing, grew more nuanced in their outlook, and got exposed to many perspectives from the social sciences and humanities.

### Teaching Highlights

High quality and capable fulltime faculty were recruited globally, meeting VinUni expectations for teaching and/or research and service, as well as organizational culture. FAS has the highest percentage of international faculty among all the Colleges and faculties. FAS faculty participated in conferences and successfully completed personal development/training (from Harvard).

Faculty received internal recognition for online teaching in the Summer and positive early student feedback for Semester 1.

### OASIS

OASIS stands on five pillars: Orientation, Advising, Study Skills, Intercultural Awareness, and Self-exploration and Growth. This is one of the most important subjects at VinUniversity for new students, helping them to transition from high school to university and expand their potential. This academic year, students had the chance to build their own academic goals, learn about time management, reading comprehension, presentation skills, etc., and meet with field experts, business leaders, and corporate CEOs. The Advisor program is a crucial part of OASIS, matching students with professors, lecturers, and faculty members in order to provide support in selecting the right study subjects or in making life choices.

#### Hackathon 2021

All 230 students, divided into 41 teams, participated in the 36-hour annual Hackathon event in March 2021. This year's theme focused on the topic of "Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development", and students were tasked to design viable solutions to tackle the problem of "air pollution" in Vietnam. In collaboration with Reactor School, the number 1 startup school for student entrepreneurs aged 15-24 in Southeast Asia, VinUniversity offered basic entrepreneurship coaching for all students.

Top 3 finalist teams were further coached by Vincom Retail in order to implement their proposed solutions.

### Events

#### Convocation Day

On October 17th, 2020, the first ever Convocation marked the official opening of VinUniversity, after over 2 years of the project's initial establishment. Over 600 people joined the ceremony and expressed their excitement at being part of the first day of a future world-leading university.

Hosted by VinUni Event Club, VinMaker Society, VinVivid, and On-Set, the Halloween Event featured a number of musical performances and a costume party. The heart of the Halloween celebration was a 2-hour long Treasure Hunt game, organized by our students.

## Career Development

### Work-Study Program

Students get the chance to experience the professional working environment early on at VinUniversity. The Work-Study program allows students to work as teaching and research assistants and to provide administrative support while earning a small income. A total of 93 students participated.

**Entrepreneurship Lab (EShipLab)** is an experimenting platform for students who have strong desire to transform ideas into real business models. Our EShip Lab provides a number of study courses and activities to develop and nurture entrepreneurial skills for students, as well as attractive seed funding amounts to establish their start-ups. An important part of EShip

Lab is the Incubation Program, which offers an 8-week self-paced virtual program to learn business basics and get mentorship from professional experts from all over South-East Asia. Upon completion of the Incubation Program, students will be given the choice to proceed into the university's own Accelerator Program, which will be launched in 2022.

In the next academic year, EShip Lab will also feature the Entrepreneurs-in-Residence program, which offers students mentorship and guidance from the country's leading experts and entrepreneurs. A Start-Up Demo Day will also be organized, and we are expecting to invite a panel of angel investors and venture capital firms to assess and evaluate student start-ups from all over Vietnam.

**Internship Orientation Program** provides structured guidance for students to plan their career paths, to find and apply for professional work positions, and to prepare themselves with the necessary skills and knowledge. The program held six sessions last year, namely:

- (1) Self-assessment and career development strategy
- (2) Effective searching for internship opportunities & personal branding
- (3) Writing professional CVs & cover letters
- (4) Successful interviewing
- (5) Professionalism in working environments
- (6) Panel discussion of HR Directors.

VinUniversity focuses on grooming students holistically and looks for opportunities to enable students to take leadership positions. VinUniversity now has 23 active student-run clubs and societies, with 93% participation rate from all students.

# LIBRARY & LEARNING RESOURCES

Our Library is one of the best academic libraries in Vietnam, especially in health and medical sciences. It holds the largest health sciences collection with access to 4,290 medical journals and 2,842 prints and electronic titles. It is also the first academic library in the country to deploy the cutting-edge Ex-Libris integrated library

system to facilitate easy access to library resources. The library is digital-resource bound with 65% of the library resources being electronic, focusing on the use of digital technologies in a contextual way including 24/7 remote access, e-reserve, library portal, RFID, self-serve check-out, Internet of things, and webchat services.



**VinUniversity Library also features a number of high-tech facilities for both student and faculty use, namely:**

- **One Button Studio (OBS)**
- **Semi-Professional Studio**
- **Maker Innovation Space**

With a holding of more than 651,018 items, the library has continued to provide a quality and balanced collection to support VinUniversity's teaching, learning, and research. The library made a strong commitment to maximize the use of OER and open textbooks to support open access and reduce students' textbook cost. To foster student's digital fluency and bolster student success, the library has conducted a number of workshops on electronic publishing, research skills, academic integrity, and VR technology training. The

library has also played a key role in supporting research and helping the university to track faculty's research footprint, and became the first member of the ORCID community in Vietnam.

# EXTERNAL ENGAGEMENT

External Engagement (EE) Department is in charge of establishing and developing lasting relationship between VinUniversity and its academic and corporate partners. In addition, the Department manages several VinGroup-sponsored programs, notably the VinGroup Science and Technology Scholarship Program for Overseas Study for Master's and Ph.D. Degrees.

Regarding **Academic Engagement**, EE reached 05 agreements on academic exchange and cooperation programs in education and research, including student exchange, faculty exchange, visiting scholars, and joint research with Cornell University, Seoul National University, Yonsei University, Western University (Canada), and the University of Technology Sydney (UTS). About 20 annual exchange opportunities will be given to VinUni students as the result of these agreements. In addition, EE worked with Cornell and UTS to establish the Study-Away Program for students from these universities to study at VinUni during the Covid outbreak.

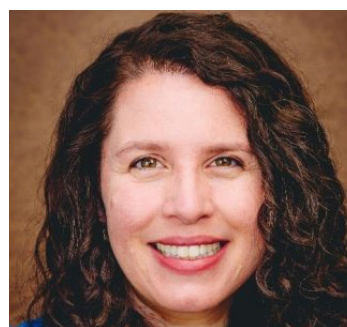

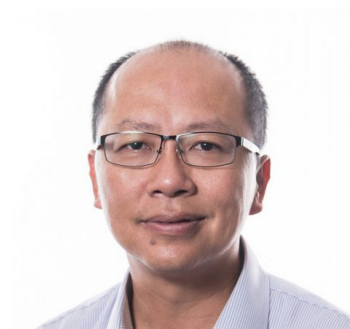

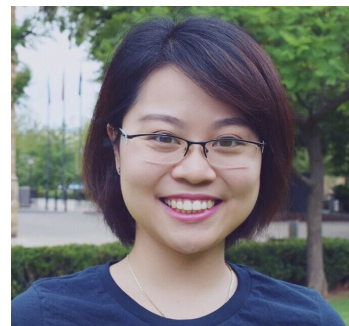
