





Affiliation Cap: Limits the number of co-authoring institutions per paper to prevent inflated credit from large research groups.

Exclusions: Certain paper types and self-citations are excluded.

Faculty Area Normalization: Adjusts for discipline-based differences in publishing patterns to ensure fair comparison across fields.
